



18th Longridge Youth Dragon Boat Championship

Saturday 26th September 2009

This annual dragon boating fixture is open to all scouts, guides, schools and youth groups. You don't need to be an expert paddler as the day starts with practice runs in the morning and in 2007 the team with the fastest time were a team of novices – it's team spirit that counts!

Racing will take place over a course of approximately 450m and in the competition there will be heats and repêchages so all teams will have at least two races, as well as the practice sessions in the morning. The finals should be between 5.30pm and 6pm.

You are welcome to make a weekend of it and camp with us but it may be helpful to bring a tent in any case to use as your base.

Refreshments will be available all day, including BBQ food, drinks, snacks and sweets.

Age groups

N.B. AGES ARE AS ON THE DATE OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

1. 14 & under – All crew members, including the drummer, must be 14 or under; except the steersman, who must be 18 or over.
2. 24 & under - Open to all those under 24.
3. Mixed Age – At least half the crew must be 15 and under. The drummer can be any age.

Dragon Boat Crew

A crew comprises of a maximum of 18 paddlers, plus a drummer and a steersman – who must be 18 or over. Unless you have a qualified steersman, the steersman will be provided from a central pool made up of Longridge team members.

Half-Crews

Don't panic if you don't have a full crew of 18, we always get a few half crews that we can join together, in fact even if you only have a quarter crew – it's worth applying and we will do our best to match you up.
