Introduction

Longridge is a charity that operates a 12-acre outdoor activity centre on the banks of the River Thames between Marlow and Maidenhead. Over 80,000 young people visit Longridge every year to take part in a range of outdoor activities, which you can find detailed on our website: <u>www.longridge.org.uk</u>

We have received funding from Departing of Levelling Up to update our facilities, that are old, prone to flooding and in many cases are just not big enough to cope with the numbers of visitors we receive now. As we are seeking to expand and welcome many more visitors, we need facilities that can adapt as we do to an ever changing market. We are therefore seeking to invest in temporary modular buildings that can be moved and adapated.

What We Need

We need to buy modular buildings that can be in place by 12th April 2024. They need to deliver the following:

- 1. To be adapted into a fully functional commercial kitchen the design of which will be sent to you on receipt of your expression of interest.
- 2. Provide bedroom space for 15 bunk beds split into 3 rooms plus a room for group leaders. As these rooms will be cited next to our main toilet block that has sufficient showers and toilets, there just needs to be overnight facilities in the space.

Both modular buildings need to be able to be raised and be moveable. We have on the next page broken this down on sizing and the other components that any tender should cover.

1 Submit Tender
